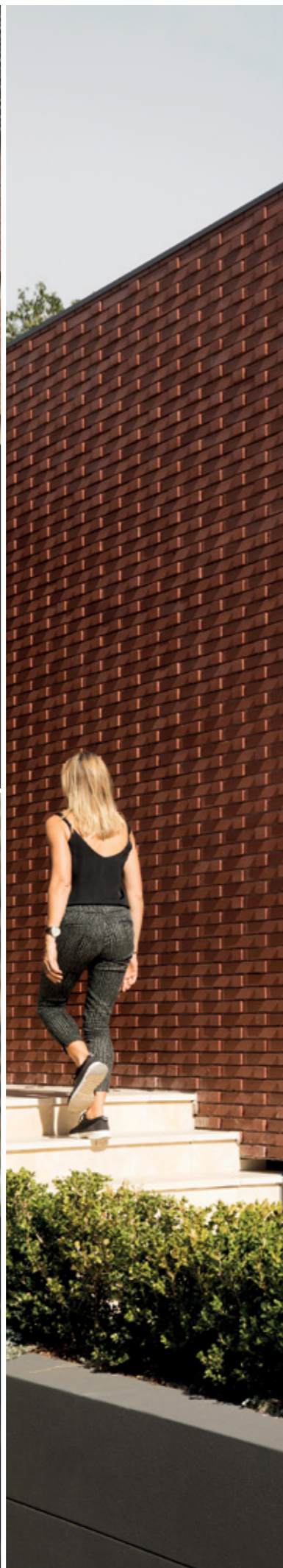

The inherent adaptability of neutrals allows this style to suit a wide range of homes and lifestyles, and is popular for those looking for an understated, restrained, and sophisticated palette.

STYLING TIPS

1. KEEP SOPHISTICATED NEUTRALS SOFT AND WELCOMING BY LAYERING TONE-ON-TONE ACROSS UNLIMITED FINISHES
2. MAXIMISE A SENSE OF MINIMALISM BY LIMITING MATERIALS AND COLOURS AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE, REPEATING THEM WHEREVER YOU CAN FOR BEST EFFECT
3. EXPERIMENT WITH TEXTURE AND GLOSS LEVELS FOR SUBTLE INTEREST. TRY TEXTURED MATT BRICKS, A HIGH-GLOSS FRONT DOOR, HONED STONE BENCHES, EXPRESSED GRAIN TIMBERS, AND RIBBED CARPETS IN SHADES OF STONE AND BEIGE
4. FOR A FRESH AND PRETTY VIBE, ADD SHADES OF SOFT PINKS ALONGSIDE CLEAN WHITEWASHED TIMBERS

STYLING TIPS

1. CREATE A SENSE OF CALM BY COMMITTING TO THE SOFTEST TONES OF GREY ACROSS ALL FINISHES AND MATERIALS
2. USE SHADES OF GREY AS A NEUTRAL BASE AND LAYER YOUR FAVOURITE MUTED COLOUR ACCENTS OVER THE TOP FOR A UNIQUE TOUCH
3. SILVERY METAL ACCENTS, PRISTINE WHITE WALLS, AND NATURAL TIMBERS ARE PERFECTLY SHOWCASED AGAINST AN ALL-GREY BACKGROUND
4. GREYS POSSESS COOL, NEUTRAL OR WARM UNDERTONES. SELECTING WITHIN ONE TONAL GROUP CREATES A STRONG AND CONSISTENT FEELING THROUGHOUT

DEEP & CONFIDENT

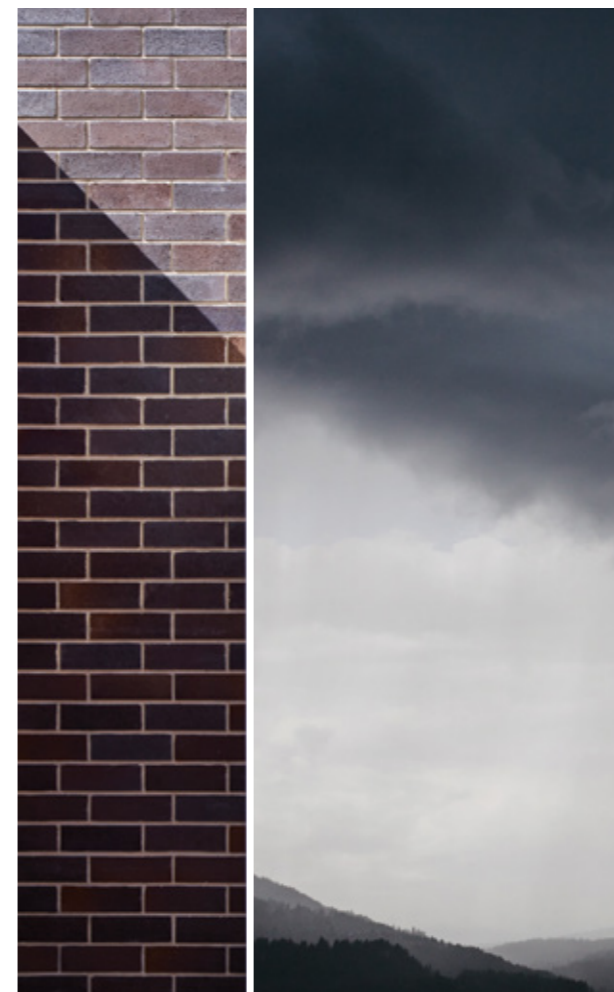

STYLING TIPS

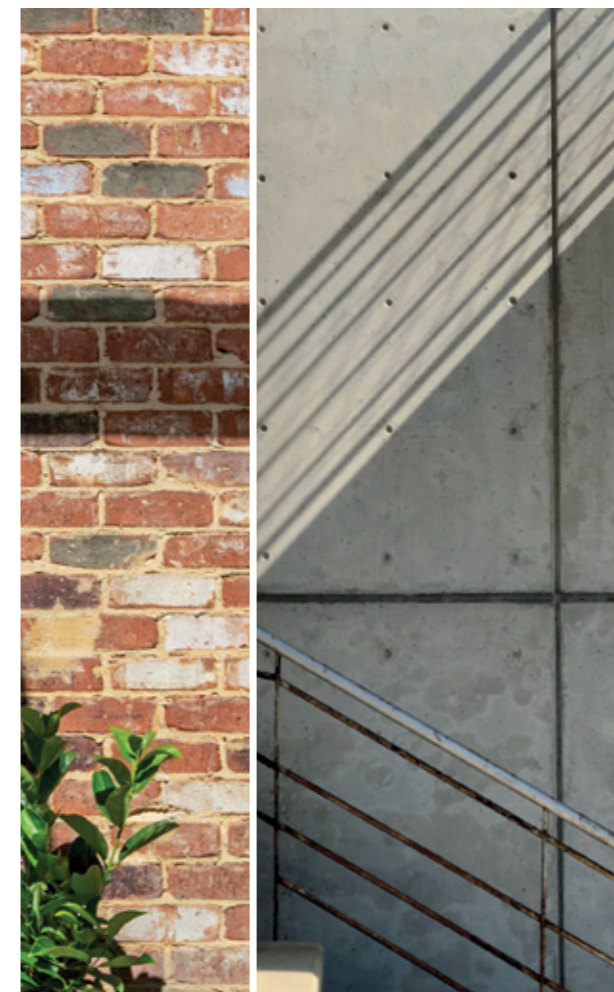
1. CHOOSE ONE HERO BRICK COLOUR, LIKE MIDNIGHT, ESPRESSO OR BLACK AND MATCH ALL OTHER FINISHES FOR A STRONG MINIMALIST APPROACH
2. USE ONLY TWO OR THREE DARK TONES, LIKE CHARCOAL WITH TWO SHADES OF BLACK FOR SUBTLE TONAL VARIATION AND INTEREST
3. SELECT BRICKS IN ONE COLOUR GROUP AND VARY THE TEXTURE OR SIZE TO CREATE BEAUTIFUL SELF-PATTERNED DETAILING
4. BRING EXTERIOR BRICKWORK INDOORS TO CREATE A POWERFUL STRUCTURAL STYLE STATEMENT, LIKE A STUNNING FIREPLACE SURROUND OR FEATURE WALL



INDUSTRIAL CHIC

RAW & URBAN

With its combination of authentic age-old materials and statement-making metals, Industrial Chic creates a unique palette that is brazen, gritty and modern.



Industrial Chic finds beauty in the charm of raw and aged finishes and the appeal of a design that focuses on the utilitarian. 1. CREATE DRAMA BY ADDING STRONG, SIMPLE AND STYLISED ELEMENTS INSIDE AND OUT, LIKE AN EXTERNAL OVERSIZED ENTRY DOOR, SCULPTURAL SOFA, OR VINTAGE-STYLE LIGHT PENDENT
2. MIX METALLIC ACCENTS FEATURING DIFFERENT OR UNIQUE FINISHES AND DETAILING FOR EFFORTLESS STYLING
3. EMBRACE FUNCTIONALITY USING EXPOSED COPPER PIPES AND INDUSTRIAL FITTINGS AS KEY DESIGN FEATURES
4. SEEK OUT RECYCLED OR POST-INDUSTRIAL MATERIALS TO IMPART A SENSE OF AUTHENTICITY AND WARMTH

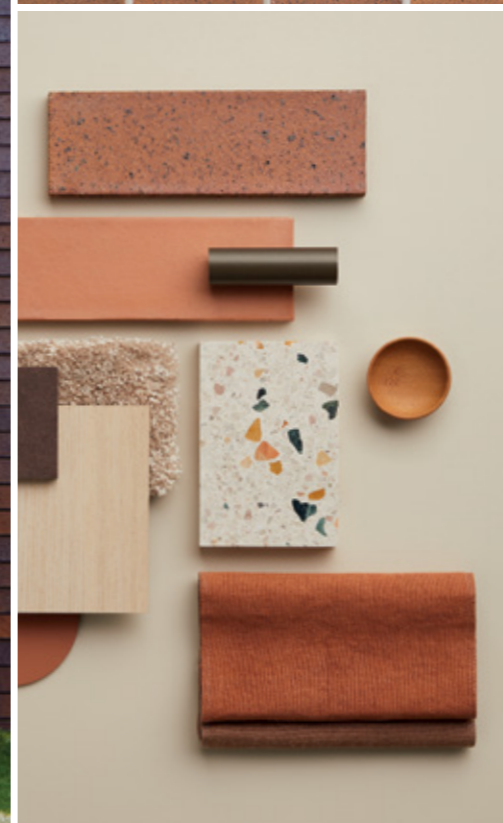
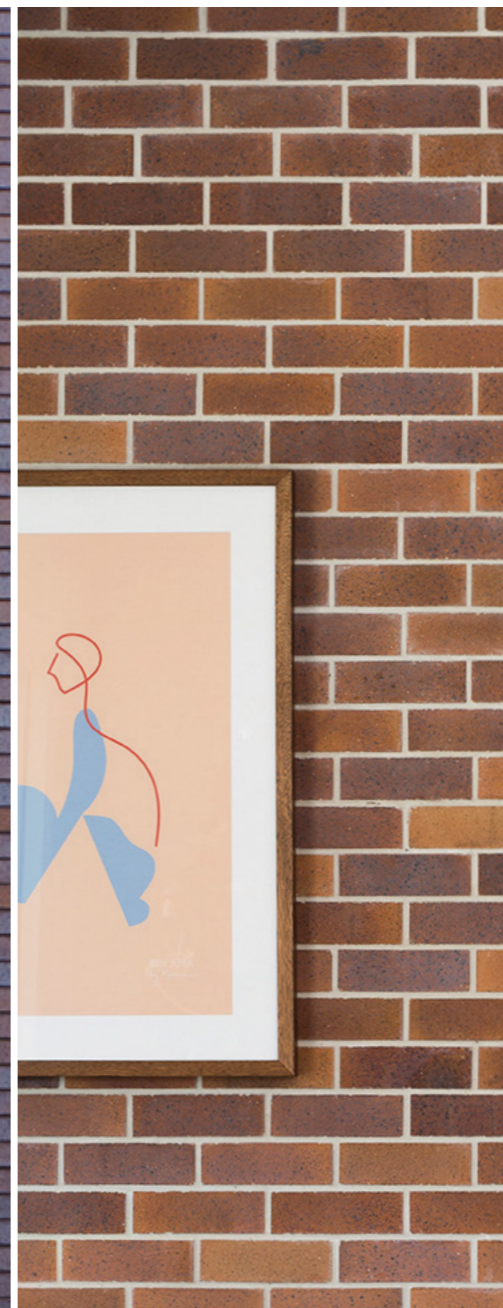
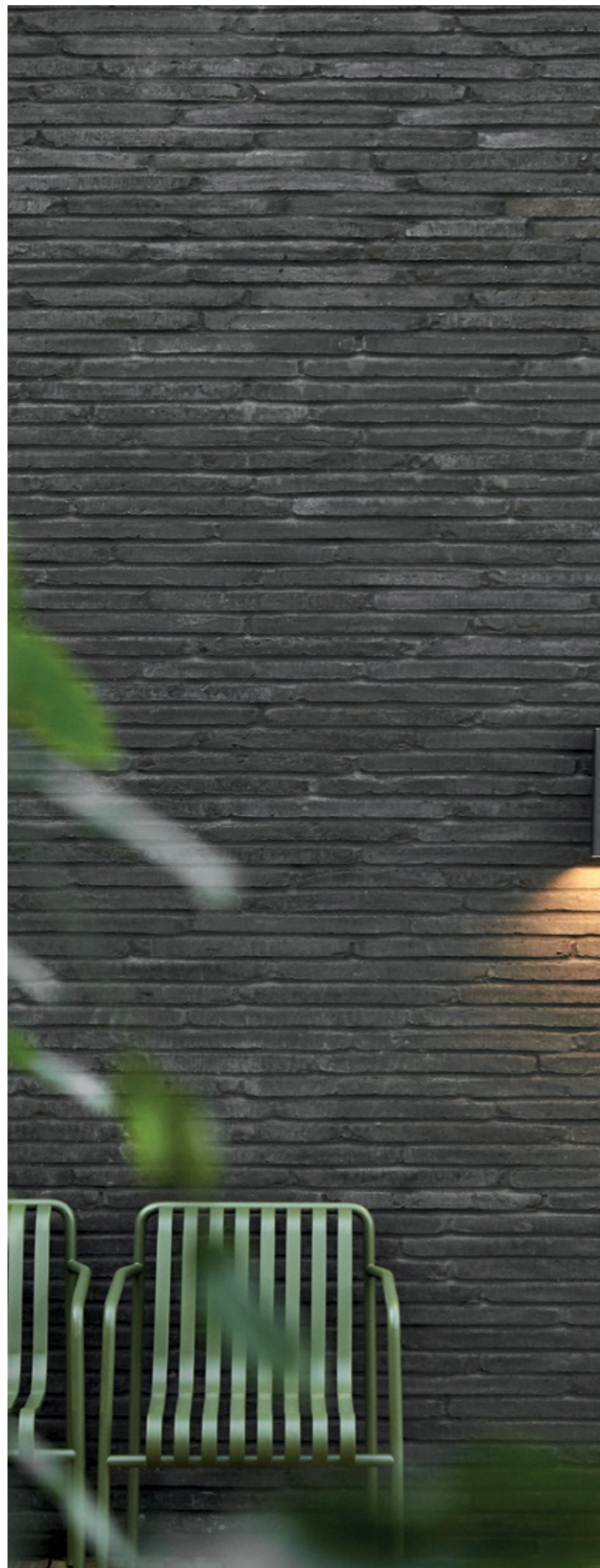

2. USE CONTEMPORARY TERRAZZO WITH A PALE BACKGROUND AND WARM FLECKS TO LINK INTO CLAY-COLOURED BRICKS AND GOLDEN ACCENTS FOR A SOFTER SPICE-MIX
3. CONTRAST SMOOTH AND TEXTURED BRICKS IN SIMILAR SHADES FOR A SUBTLE PLAY OF LIGHT

3. LAYER LUSTROUS DEEP NAVY OR ALMOST-BLACK GREENS WITH THE CLASSIC BLACK AND BRASS ACCENTS
4. GLOSS LEVELS MATTER. USE A SUPER-MATT TEXTURED BRICK WITH HIGHLY POLISHED MARBLE AND SATIN WEATHERED BRASS FOR AN OPTIMAL MIX

STYLING TIPS

1. PAINTING OVER NEW, SMOOTH BRICKS LAID WITH A FLUSH MORTAR IS THE SIMPLEST AND MOST DURABLE WAY TO ACHIEVE THE LOOK AND FEEL OF AUTHENTIC VINTAGE BRICKWORK
2. APPLY A WHITEWASH PAINT OVER WARM TERRACOTTA BRICKS TO CREATE A BEAUTIFUL RUSTIC LOOK
3. FOR A STRIKING LAYERED EFFECT, USE A HIGH-GLOSS FINISH WHEN PAINTING WITH THE BLACKEST OF BLACKS OR A CRISP WHITE TO CONTRAST WITH TEXTILES AND TIMBERS
4. PAINTING MORE POROUS BRICKS WITH ROUGHER TEXTURES WILL PROVIDE A HIGH CONTRAST AGAINST OTHER POLISHED SURFACES LIKE TIMBER, TILES AND CONCRETE



OUR TOP TIPS FOR CHOOSING YOUR BRICK

Bricks are strong, durable and a popular choice for new home builders and renovators.

With such a broad range of great options available, choosing bricks may seem overwhelming. Here are our top tips to guide you in confidently choosing the right brick for your home.

1 Style of your house

The material that your house is built from also forms the foundation (literally) of its aesthetic appeal. The colour, shape, size and texture of the bricks you choose will influence the overall look and feel of your house. Before you make your final decision, it's worth gathering ideas online, from display homes, websites and magazines. When renovating, consider how new bricks will appear alongside existing materials.

Many homeowners find it helpful to pull together a "mood board" of images of the styles of homes they are drawn to. Simply save images (either physically or digitally) of favourite buildings, bricks, trims and even interior ideas. As your mood board develops, it will often become apparent which style of home best suits your aesthetic and lifestyle.

2 Consider your location

Bricks are graded to suit different environmental conditions. The location of your home will determine which grade you need. If you live near the coast or have high-saline soil, you may benefit from exposure grade bricks (EXP)* which have heightened resistance to salt attack. General purpose (GP) grade bricks are suited to all other building types and locations. Talk to your builder about any special environmental conditions you should be aware of.



3 How does it look

COLOUR & TEXTURE

One of the big current trends in exteriors, textural elements can add character, charm and individuality to a home. Brick textures range from a smooth finish, which has a consistent surface and ceramic-like appearance with straight edges, to a more artisan-style effect, with a dragged or ripped appearance for a weathered look.

You can even get glazed bricks that have a shiny ceramic tile look for feature walls (perfect for the mid-century design trend) or beautiful Crafted Sandstocks bricks that give a home an authentic raw beauty that no other material can achieve.

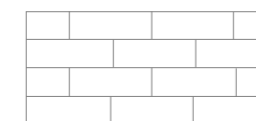
SIZE

Bricks are also available in a range of dimensions. Decisions about size may depend on factors such as the proportions of the house, the purpose of the bricks and the visual effect you need.

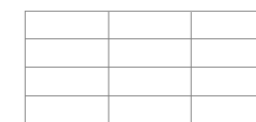
4 How does it stack up

A bond is a pattern in which bricks are laid. The most commonly used bond is Stretcher bond, which consists of courses of full bricks where every course is offset half a brick from the course below. Stacked and Flemish are also popular bonds that can achieve alternative looks, or get creative with hit-and-miss brickwork to achieve screening and allow natural light to shine through your space.

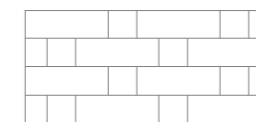
STRETCHER BOND

5 What holds it together

MORTAR COLOURS

An off-white mortar between darker coloured bricks will add contrast and highlight the shape of each brick, making the bricks the hero. However, matching the colour of the mortar with that of the brick will soften the brickwork and present a unified appearance. This is especially common with the use of lighter shades of bricks.

MORTAR JOINT FINISH

With the mortar joint, you can choose a round ironed, flush or struck finish, depending on whether you want to highlight or soften the effect of the brickwork. For instance, a raked joint will create shadowing for contrast and interest. A flush joint will minimise shadow with a flat, streamlined look.

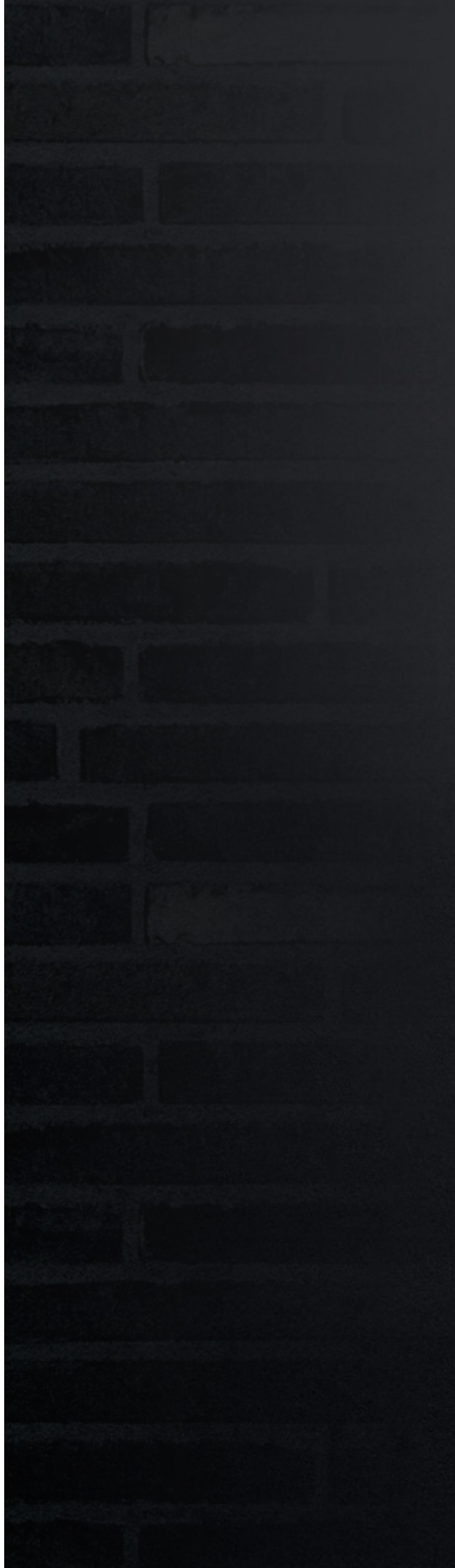
