





High textured brick walls create protected outdoor living spaces, blurring the divide between interior and exterior in this striking Queensland home. The east and west wings of the 'H' shaped footprint form summer and winter courtyards, becoming open air rooms with inviting views that frame the landscaping in and around the house.

Designed to sit comfortably in its mature landscape, a small, detached studio situated within the winter courtyard houses a pottery kiln that required a chimney. This became the inspiration for the first of the three symmetrical chimneys that give the house its unique design and name.

The exterior and interior walls of the home are constructed using Crevole from the **PGH Bricks & Pavers** Coastal Hamptons range; a product chosen for its robustness to withstand Queensland's harsh weather conditions, and its structural and textural qualities.
